

PIANI Care and Maintenance

Our products are made of natural materials such as wood, leather, and fabric. These materials have natural variations in texture and color – knots, grain marks, or folds – which make each piece unique. These are not defects, but signs of authentic craftsmanship. Proper care helps extend the life and beauty of each item.

Wood Care

Wood is natural: knots, color, and grain variations are normal. Due to natural variations in materials and unforeseen factors during production, the final product's finish may differ slightly from the sample provided.

- Clean surfaces with a damp cloth and neutral soap. Avoid abrasive or alcohol-based cleaners on wood.
- Wipe thoroughly with a clean, dry cloth. Do not press hard while dusting or cleaning wooden surfaces.
- Wipe up spills immediately to avoid stains: water can cause cracks and warping in wood. Use a dry towel to blot liquids.
- Avoid rooms with large humidity fluctuations and do not place near heat sources like radiators.
- Do not place wooden furniture in direct sunlight: wood color changes with exposure to daylight.

Lacquered Surfaces

- Clean lacquered surfaces with a damp cloth and neutral soap. Avoid special detergents unless instructions are followed.
- Wipe thoroughly with a clean, dry cloth. Do not press hard while dusting lacquered surfaces.
- Do not let stains dry on lacquered surfaces. Use a dry towel to blot liquids.

Fabric Care

- Do not expose fabric to heat or direct sunlight. Light colors may stain from contact with clothing or print.
- Clean fabric in the pile direction. Clean with a microfiber damp cloth and neutral soap. Never use abrasive or polishing detergents.
- Wipe thoroughly with a clean, dry cloth. Do not scrub or press too hard. Use a dry towel to blot liquids.
- Refer to the specific Fabric instructions or contact us when in doubt.

Leather Care

- Condition leather 2-4 times per year.
- Wrinkles and veins are normal on leather. Light colors may stain from contact with clothing or print.
- Clean with a microfiber damp cloth and neutral soap. Never use abrasive or polishing detergents.
- Wipe thoroughly with a clean, dry cloth. Do not press hard while dusting leather. Use a dry towel to blot liquids.
- Refer to the Leather type specific instructions or contact us when in doubt.

Product Use and Handling

- Lift products by their frame. Avoid impacts with objects.
- Do not swing, rock, or sit improperly. Distribute weight evenly.
- Check and tighten screws regularly.

End of Life

- Dispose of all materials responsibly according to local regulations.
- Use authorized waste disposal services.
